Come join the Southern New Hampshire chapter of NEMBA for the fun, while helping to save the trails in Bear Brook State Park! The 7th annual Bear Brook Boogie will be held on Sunday June 10th at 10 AM, with registration opening at 8:30 AM. There will be a kid's ride, along with a 10 mile beginner/intermediate loop and a 20 mile intermediate/advanced loop. Ride fast or just cruise, the trails are arrowed so everyone knows where to go and you don't have to worry about getting lost! All riders leave at the same time after a short rider's meeting and raffle. There will be lots of raffle prizes and lots of fun! All the money raised by the Boogie goes directly to the park to rebuild and maintain the trails.

Bear Brook State Park, located in Allenstown NH, offers over 30 miles of mountain biking trails from mellow woods roads to challenging single track. Ride Profile : Yudicky Farm

Rating: Intermediate

Location: Nashua, NH

Directions: Exit 5W off of Route 3 in Nashua to Rt.111a West/ Main Dunstable Rd. Head down Rt. 111a West, for approx. 2.5 miles. Pass the (closed) Old Ridge Rd on the left. About 20 yds past Old Ridge Rd, you will see baseball-fields on the right. Turn right and park in the back lot of the baseball fields.

Yudicky Farm is 2 trail systems split by Route 111a. On the south side is the Spaghetti Bowl and Twisted Sister, and on the north side are some newer trails built by NEMBA Barbed Wire, Son of Barb Wire, and others. The trails here are fairly flat, and for what this trail system lacks in elevation rise, it more than makes up with technical single-track, tight turns, and fun. This trail system is great for an after work ride.
